

# CO<sub>2</sub> Performance Ladder Policy Statement

## Version 3.1 - Niveau 3

To achieve our objectives, we will implement an active CO<sub>2</sub> management system integrated into our current VCA\*\* and ISO9001 management systems. While safeguarding business reliability, we strive for continuous improvement of the energy efficiency of our processes through:

- Monitoring, measuring, and verifying our energy consumption that generates CO<sub>2</sub> emissions.
- Evaluating and adapting the proposed reduction measures.
- Providing the necessary resources required to implement the proposed reduction measures.
- Raising awareness and promoting energy consciousness among our internal and external stakeholders.
- Actively participating in initiatives aimed at reducing CO<sub>2</sub> emissions and promoting sustainability within the railway sector.
- Reporting and communicating periodically and transparently, both internally and externally, about our efforts to reduce CO<sub>2</sub> emissions.
